CRI Worldwide has opened its Center for the Research of Pain Disorders at its new clinical research facility at the Kirkbride Center in Philadelphia.

The center conducts Phase I through Phase IV inpatient and outpatient clinical-trial services, with specific expertise in bioequivalence, bioavailability, pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics

(PK/PD) studies, cardiac safety (QTc), and proof-of-concept work. Its staff has conducted more than 100 clinical trials, including extensive experience in neuropathic pain, post-hepatic neuralgia back pain, and fibromyalgia.

The new center is led by Daniel Gruener, M.D., a recognized expert in the areas of analgesic and neuropathic pain research.
